

Allowable Activities

- Employment and Training Activities
- Humanitarian Assistance Activities
 - ▶ Delivering medicine, food, or other supplies to individuals affected by COVID-19
 - Helping set up quarantine areas
 - Organizing and coordinating recovery, quarantine, or other related activities
- Cleanup Activities
 - Cleaning schools or sanitizing quarantine areas after use



Eligible Participants

- Dislocated Workers
- Workers laid-off as a result of the disaster
- Self-employed individuals unemployed or underemployed because of the disaster
- Long-term unemployed individuals



Initial Award - \$12 million

- Estimated Total Program Funding \$300 million (nationwide)
- Providing COVID-19 relief as well as support amidst annual budget cuts
- Initial Metro Atlanta Allocations

- Additional Requests made by Atlanta and Cobb
 - Opportunity for collaboration across boards in Metro Atlanta



Timeline

- Opportunity Posted March 19, 2020
 - 15 days to submit Initial Application
- Initial Application March 31, 2020
 - 45 days allowed for USDOL to review
- Notice of Award April 22, 2020
 - 60 days to complete full application
- Full Application June 21, 2020
