The **Georgia Apprenticeship Mechatronics** (Automation and Craft Skills Track) program provides participants with **education** and **training** in technical maintenance. Even without any previous technical experience, you will gain **valuable** skills through a combination of classroom instruction and **on-the-job** learning that prepares you for a **career** in advanced manufacturing as a mechatronics technician.

As part of the **apprenticeship**, you'll have the opportunity to receive **16 weeks** of training in addition to **paid on-the-job** learning alongside an **industry mentor**, gaining knowledge, and technical skills, and industry-recognized credentials needed to be **successful**.

WHAT WE'RE LOOKING FOR:

- Must be 18 years old at the start of the program on June 1, 2021
- Ready to learn the skills and technical knowledge needed to be a mechatronics technician
- Committing to be a part of this paid apprenticeship which includes:
 - *Successful completion of 16-weeks of training at Georgia Piedmont Technical College*
 - *Successful completion of 6,000 hours of on-the-job learning as a mechatronics apprentice with a local employer in DeKalb, Newton, or Rockdale counties*
