Eligibility Requirements

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Commitment and availability for the entirety of the program – 52 Weeks
- Qualify as a military veteran; woman; a person with a disability, or racial minority
- Complete the apprenticeship program application line
- Possess a drivers license or state ID for identification purposes
- Consent to a background check
- Pass the cyber apprenticeship intake assessment
