2024 Advancing Black Strategists Initiative Movement Fellowship Program Application

There is significant need for Black leadership within the movement for economic justice and democracy. The Advancing Black Strategists Initiative (ABSI) seeks to provide hands-on campaign experience and training to aspiring Black strategists through the Movement Fellowship Program. This program will offer Fellows 15 months of direct campaign experience with an existing, Black-led Southern worker campaign. Concurrently, Fellows will take academic coursework through the W.E.B. Du Bois Southern Center for Studies in Public Policy at Clark Atlanta University to deepen their campaign experience in a broader labor context and put them in relationship with thought leaders throughout the movement. The cohort of Fellows assigned to different campaigns will debrief experiences with each other and ABSI mentors to strengthen relationships helpful in future career placement. Simultaneously, Fellows will contribute needed capacity to critical campaigns, giving them an added boost and visibility to win and sustain those victories. ABSI will also elevate strategies used by these Black-led, Southern campaigns into national and global discourse on how workers are attempting to expand their ability to organize and collectively bargain.

This is a full-time fellowship that has a salary range of \$55,000 - \$60,000 per year plus benefits (medical, dental, professional development, etc.). Relocation IS required if you do not live in your assigned Host Campaign location.
