- 1st Place High School: **\$300**
- 1st Place Post High-School/College: **\$500**

# Portraying the Immigrant Experience: *an Art Contest*

## *Judging Criteria:*

- Creativity and originality
- Technical skill
- Interpretation and clarity of the theme
- Overall presentation

## *Contest Rules:*

- The contest is open to all Georgia artists ages 12 - 25
- All entries must be a two dimensional photograph, drawing or painting in any of the following media: Photography, Watercolor, Oil Painting, Pastels, Pencil, Ink, Acrylic, Crayon, Charcoal, Tempera, Chalk
- Measurements are not to exceed 22" x 28"
- The design must be ORIGINAL. No copies are to be entered in the competition
- Artists can submit up to 3 designs
- The organization reserves the right to disqualify any entry that does not adhere to the rules.
- By entering the contest, students grant the organization permission to use images of their artwork for promotional purposes.
