In addition to poor health outcomes and low health care capacity, rural high needs areas have lower incomes, labor force participation, and educational attainment, as well as higher adult disability and poverty rates relative to both the Southeast and the United States. We highlight these disparities to show that rural high needs areas have additional barriers to accessing in-person health care providers beyond limited availability of services. Our analysis implies that policy actions targeted at increasing broadband subscription and device access in rural health care deserts may help its residents access health care services. The task force found that a college degree continues to confer substantial benefits on average, but there is emerging evidence that some degree programs provide little to no return on investment.
