- From **Accenture**: Today, we stand at the next inflection point with the rise of generative and agentic AI. This technology is transforming industries at an unprecedented pace, and in retail, it is reinventing how people shop, how businesses operate and how employees work. The urgency for retailers—and in particular grocers—to adopt AI is paramount, given they generally operate with lower margins in a highly competitive landscape. They have incomes below the federal poverty level (FPL) — too low to qualify for financial help in the ACA marketplaces — yet they don't qualify for Medicaid because they live in one of the ten states that have not adopted the ACA Medicaid expansion. The remaining non-expansion states should close the coverage gap by adopting Medicaid expansion. The last five years saw rapid and welcome progress reversing some of these trends—but it will take a long time to heal the previous damage, even if the post-2019 momentum can be sustained, which looks very unlikely at the moment. The 2024 survey finds that many metrics remained stable year over year. Expectations for future revenue and employment growth, recent applications for credit, and the outcomes of those applications mostly held steady.
